Artwork creation

As students begin to create their artwork, here are a few things to keep in mind.

Paper Size

It's important to use the correct paper size. This is determined by the size of the tiles you have chosen.

- 6" x 8" tiles = 8 ½" x 11" paper
- 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" tiles = **Square paper** no smaller than 7 ¼"
- 6" x 6" tiles = **Square paper** no smaller than 7 ¼"

Using the correct size paper ensures that the images will be proportional when reproduced onto the tiles. If required, the appropriate paper size has been included in your supply box.

Label Artwork

Once artwork is completed, be sure to include the following information on the **BACK** of each artwork:

- Student Name- First & Last
- Teacher, Grade/Class

Remember to use pencil so that it doesn't show through to the front!

CHOOSE THESE!

For the best results please choose from the following list of mediums

- Markers
- Tempera or Acrylic Paints
- Crayons (press hard)
- Paper Collages
- Photos
- Bold Intense Watercolors
- Black Marker for outlining

DO NOT use these!

We can NOT process artwork that has any of the following

- Glitter - of ANY kind
- Abrasives (sand, salt, etc.)
- 3D materials
- Scratch art/Scratch board
- Copyright/trademark items*
- STICKY/MESSY artwork**
- Fluorescent, neon & metallic***
- Colored or lead pencil ****



PAPER

For the best results please use the provided art paper.

- Size: all paper should be: 8 1/2" x 11"
- Recommended weight: 60-70#
- Construction paper - often does not reproduce true to color. Blues can look purple, blacks can look grey or green etc. *Use with caution.*



copyright/trademark items*

Due to existing copyright laws we cannot accept copyright images. This includes but is not limited to: images, logos, brand names, emojis, video, cartoon & anime characters, stickers, magazine and newspaper prints. **If you are unsure we recommend you do another project.**



STICKY/MESSY artwork**

We cannot process artwork that is sticky, or comes off on your hands.

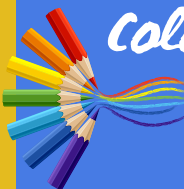
- Chalks, Oil Pastels & Cray Pas - MUST be sprayed **and** cannot be sticky or come off on your hands when touched.



Fluorescent, neon & metallic***

These mediums do NOT reproduce true to color. To avoid unhappy families, please avoid using them.

Colored or lead pencil ****



Pencil drawings are usually VERY light and do not reproduce well. Although we won't return them, we recommend using a different medium for the project.



Try This!

Rub your hand across the artwork.

If residue comes off on your hand we will not be able to process it. Please re-spray the artwork with a fixative.



Try This!

Hold the artwork across the room. Can it be seen clearly?

Yes - Great! Your art will reproduce well.
No - Darken areas that are too light to be seen. Outline details with marker.

ART Tips

Please review these tips to create artwork that will reproduce well.

Create art that sells!

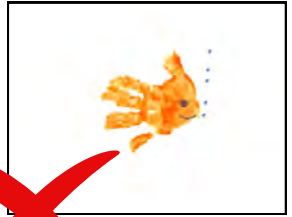
- Skin tones must be heavily covered and as opaque as possible
- Recolor & repaint any lightly colored areas
- Erase unwanted marks, pencil lines and smudges
- Trim excess paper that hangs over the edge of the paper
- Consider using a black marker to outline details
- Have artists sign and date their masterpiece (use our Signature Template to avoid the edge)



Fill the entire art paper.

Secure all pieces of collages to ensure they don't fall off.



Completing the project

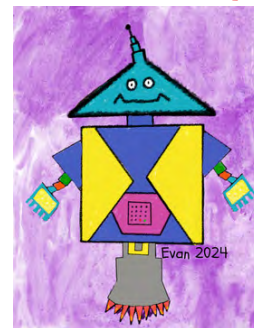
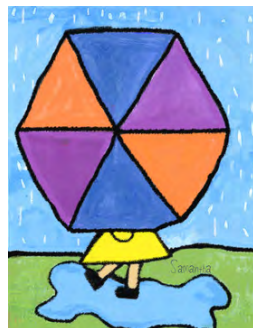
- **Identify the artwork**
 - Using pencil- write the artist's first and last name, teacher & grade on the **BACK** of the artwork
 - Applying labels? Apply the label to the **BACK-TOP** of the artwork after the project is completed.
- **Artwork orientation**
 - Using pencil - place a "T" on the **BACK- TOP** of the artwork to ensure proper orientation



Add 1" border to keep details from the edge. Erase guide lines.
Cropping can occur during reproduction!

Use bright, vibrant colors! Pencil and lightly colored art will not reproduce or will appear washed out on products

Ordering process

Prepare Family Packets

Assemble a family packet to be sent home. The packet should include :

- Original Artwork
- Reserve Your Spot Letter* with permission form
- Flyer (provided by Original Works as needed)
- Order Form (if applicable)

*A master has been provided in this guide and Online in the Customer Care Center. Be sure to complete the necessary information before distributing. You can also create your own letter.

Send Home

Send the family packets home for families to order. Be sure you are staying on schedule!

Collect Orders

When orders are returned, they should include:

- Original Artwork
- Completed & signed permission slip (if applicable)
- Order Form (if applicable)
- Payment to the school/organization

Shipping process



for safe travels, put all of the artwork folders into a large plastic bag

Prepare orders for shipment

1. Separate artwork based on the number of Tiles to be reproduced:
 - If only 1 tile is being made for ALL of the artwork, then you don't need to separate them
 - If some of the artwork needs 2 tiles made, put those in a separate folder
 - If some need 3, put those in the next folder, etc.
2. An order form has been included in this guide. Although they are not required, you may find them helpful for organizing your program. If you choose to submit artwork with order forms, be sure to tape them to the back of the artwork.
3. Stack the folders/bags into a box or padded envelope and ship to the address which is at the bottom of Form W. We recommend using a traceable service.

Payment

An invoice will be generated once the tiles have been shipped. Appropriate shipping & handling charges will be invoiced with the completed orders. If you prefer to send payment with your orders, please generate a single check to Original Works for the total order.

Tiles arrive at school

Celebrate! When you receive your completed tiles they are divided by the number of tiles and not by the grade/teacher. The tiles are packed in the box in layers, with the artwork in a folder placed directly on top of the layer of corresponding tiles so that they are easy to match up.

Tile installation

Interior Walls Only

The following instructions are designed to provide a guideline for successful installation of your tile wall. We strongly recommend that you use a qualified tile installer/contractor to install your tile wall. Careful installation will ensure the life of your product. Original Works will not be held liable for tiles that are damaged or broken during the installation process.

To avoid potentially scratching the tile surface when installing, use of a sand-less grout is highly recommended. We also recommend the use of tile spacers. Spacers will ensure a consistent width between tiles, help prevent misalignment during installation, and improve the overall appearance of the project.

Installation

1. Using a notched spreader (normally supplied with the tile adhesive) apply the adhesive evenly over the surface to which the tiles will be secured. The ridges in the adhesive allow for positioning and bedding of the tiles. Cover an area of about 1 m (1 yd.) at a time, to prevent the adhesive from drying out.
2. Start with the first tile in the bottom most left hand corner by pressing it until it is firmly fixed. Continue by adding the tiles to the right side, building out one row at a time. Continue with successive rows of tiles until the whole area has been built up, applying new adhesive as/when required. Periodically, use a damp sponge to wipe any excess adhesive from the surface of the tiles.

Grouting

Non-abrasive (sand-less) grout can be applied 24 hours after tiling. Professionals use a “squeegee” type tool, but a piece of dense foam sponge or a rubber spreader are also suitable.

1. Use the spreader to force the grout into the gaps between the tiles. Spread in all directions to ensure the gaps are well filled.
2. After covering the surface area to be worked, wipe away the excess grout with another sponge, rinsing it frequently in a bucket of clean water. To give an even, polished finish to the grout, use a piece of dowel to run down the grout lines, to ensure an even depth and thickness to the grouting lines.
3. When the grout is dry, polish the tile area with a soft cloth.

Use the grid below to position tiles. Start from the left hand side at the bottom of the wall. It is best to layout the entire mural before beginning any installation.

Customer service

Although we thoroughly inspect all orders before shipping, occasionally a less than perfect order gets through. We call this a "Fix-It". If it happens, our Customer Service team is ready to assist!

1. What is a "Fix-It"?

- If the order/product meets one or more of the following criteria:
 - ★ Material defect: chipped tile
 - ★ Improper reproduction: artwork is upside down or the wrong image
 - ★ Missing product: you were invoiced for a product but never received it.

3. What is not a "Fix-It"?

- We produce Artwork "As Is", and do not modify the artwork in anyway.
 - ★ Examples include:
 - ★ We cannot remove pencil lines or ink that has come thru from writing on the back of the art
 - ★ The entire piece of artwork is captured. This means:
 - ★ If there is a lot of empty or white space on the paper, there will be a lot of empty or white space on the product
 - ★ A small drawing will be a small image. We do not "zoom in" or crop to the image
 - ★ The image on the product is reproduced in proportion with the product it's on.
 - ★ Details missing that were drawn 1" or closer to the edge
 - ★ Images appearing too light or too small on a product



Please review and follow Art Instructions. We can not be held responsible for redoing products that do not comply with our stated art instructions.

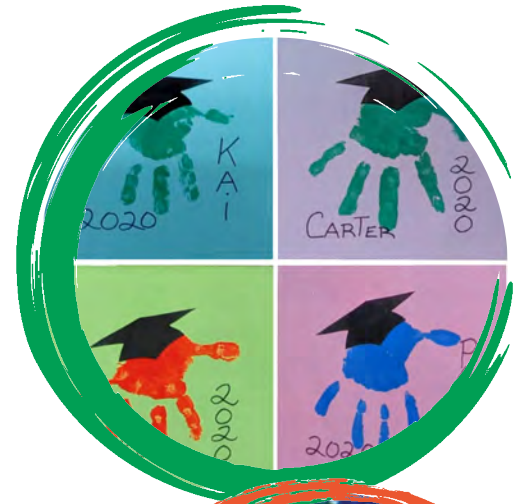
